

# HAND RANKING

## ROYAL FLUSH

A royal flush is an ace high straight flush. For example, 10-J-Q-K-A all of diamonds.



#### **STRAIGHT**

Five cards of sequential value. Every possible straight will contain either a 5 or a 10. For example, 5-6-7-8-9 with different suits.



#### STRAIGHT FLUSH

A straight flush is a five-card straight, all in the same suit. For example, 6-7-8-9-10 all of clubs.



# THREE OF A KIND

Three cards of the same value. For example, three 9s.



#### FOUR OF A KIND

Four of a kind, or quads, are four cards of equal value. For example, four jacks.



#### TWO PAIRS

This is two cards of one value and another two cards of another value. For example, two 2s and two 8s.



## **FULL HOUSE**

A full house contains a set (3) of cards of one value and a pair of another value. For example, 9-9-9-4-4.



## PAIRS

One pair is two cards of the same rank. For example, two 3s.



#### **FLUSH**

A flush is any 5 cards, all of the same suit. For example, 3-5-7-9-10 all of diamonds.



# HIGH CARD

The hand with the highest card(s) wins. If two or more players hold the highest card, a kicker comes into play
